Natural gas costs an average of \$530 vs. electricity which costs an average of \$1,050 per year.






The natural gas industry supports thousands of people from Arizona with stable and good paying jobs.

Natural gas generates 43% of the state's electricity.

Since 2007, CO2 emissions in Arizona have declined 18.9%.



The state of Arizona has the potential to produce 43.0 tBtu of RNG per year by 2040.

Renewable natural gas (RNG) is any pipelinecompatible gaseous fuel derived from biogenic or other renewable sources that has less carbon emissions than traditional natural gas.
