Natural gas costs an average of \$400 vs. electricity which costs an average of \$1,300 per year.



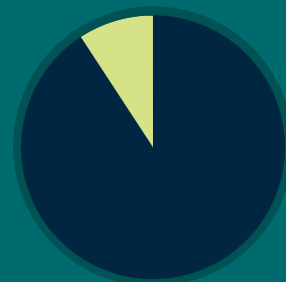

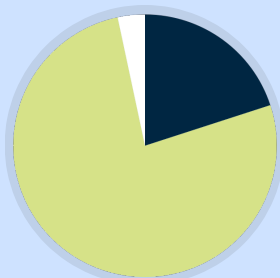

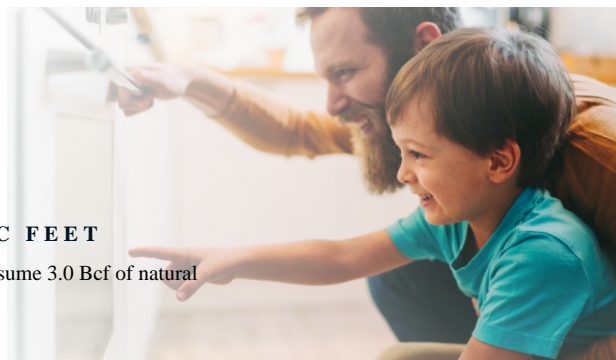
